Nazery Khalid, the Honorary Secretary of Association of Marine Industries of Malaysia (AMIM), will draw on his diverse experience in the fields of maritime economics, policy research and consultancy to share his holistic forecast of Malaysia's maritime scene in 2018. He will discuss the new issues and challenges to be faced by the various players in the maritime industry ecosystem, including ports, shipyards and maritime support service providers, and touch on the opportunities created by the Malaysian Shipbuilding & Ship Repair Industry Strategic Plan and Malaysia Shipping Master Plan.

Nazery Khalid is Honorary Secretary of Association of Marine Industries of Malaysia (AMIM), an association featuring Malaysian shipyards and various enterprises and institutions involved in various activities in the marine industries. He is widely regarded as among Malaysia's foremost subject matter experts in the field of maritime economics.

Nazery spent ten years at Maritime Institute of Malaysia (MIMA), a maritime policy think tank, as Research Coordinator and Senior Fellow and Head, Center for Maritime Economics and Industries from 2004 to 2014. He has published over 250 articles on various topics and issues in the maritime sector – including three research papers published by MIMA, chapters in books and publications in refereed journals – and has presented and chaired in nearly 130 forums, seminars and conferences worldwide. He was a Visiting Scholar at Cardiff University in 2010, Universitè Paris Diderot in 2011 and Sun Yat-Sen University in Guangzhou, China in 2013, and taught Maritime Economics to MBA in Shipping Management students at Universiti Industri Selangor, Malaysia in 2010.

In addition to his prolific publications, Nazery has presented papers and has spoken at nearly 100 conferences, seminars and forums worldwide on ports, shipping, logistics, offshore oil and gas and supply chain. He also occasionally conducts training and carries out consultancy work in those areas.

Prior to his involvement in the maritime sector, Nazery spent 15 years working in the financial services industry including in commercial and merchant banking, stockbroking, corporate finance and venture capital. He holds an MBA from International Islamic University, Malaysia and a BA in Business Administration from Ottawa University, Kansas, USA.
