Written Advocacy

Date: 7th July 2022

Time: 5:00 p.m. – 6:30 p.m. MYT

The first instalment will focus on the significance and drafting issues arising from particular key documents and procedural stages in an arbitration. In particular, it will discuss certain recurring issues including "memorial" vs. pleadings-style submissions, tips for effective written advocacy, and other practical considerations. Audience participation will be solicited through live polls during the workshop.

Oral Advocacy (Part I)

Date: 1st September 2022

Time: 5:00 p.m. – 6:30 p.m. MYT

This workshop shifts the focus to oral submissions – in particular opening, closing, and interim application submissions. Key issues include jurisdictional disputes, addressing foreign law, and effective ways of communicating with the tribunal through demonstratives and multimedia presentations. Similar to the first session, audience participation is anticipated through polling and breaks in the presentation.

Oral Advocacy (Part II)

The final workshop is dedicated to cross-examination. This longer session accommodates a snapshot of a mock hearing with the speakers cross-examining a quantum expert from a leading forensic accounting firm. The intention is to illustrate key do's and don'ts in cross-examination. As with the prior sessions, audience participation will be included.
