FORMULATING A SUCCESSFUL COVID-19 CLAIM UNDER MIDDLE **EAST & SOUTH ASIA CONSTRUCTION** AND ENGINEERING CONTRACTS

The COVID-19 pandemic has caused delay and disruption to Construction & Engineering projects across the globe throughout 2020 and into 2021. Many entities within the C&E Supply Chain submitted "contractor's claims" to obtain relief, and these will crystalise, as the projects proceed to completion, into formal disputes for additional time and costs. In this webinar, the Panel will discuss the Contractor's optimal strategy to prepare and win COVID-19 claims with reference to FIDIC Contracts and the laws of the Middle East. The Panel will also touch on the AIAC's suite of Standard Form of Building Contracts (AIAC SFCs) and the Law of Malaysia, including the dispute resolution procedures therein. In addition, the Panel will discuss the importance and the role of independent technical experts (Quantum/Delay) in international arbitration, which is the final forum for dispute resolution in FIDIC and the AIAC SFCs.
