#### TITLE: THE AMENDED UBBL AND ITS OBLIGATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION PROFESSIONALS

Compliance to Statutory Requirements are standards prescribed by the Local Government to make sure that the safety of its occupants are taken care of by the relevant stakeholders. This is the consequences of a major fire incident in Kuala Lumpur during the 70s, that the Uniform Building By-laws 1984 ('UBBL') was crafted under the main legislature of the Street, Drainage and Building Act 1974. The UBBL has since undergone its own 'reincarnation' adopting many other provisions inclusive of the Malaysian Standards ('MS') beyond the call of public safety to also include Energy Conservation.

Apparently the UBBL was 'drafted' as a prescriptive law with vague terminologies that even professionals find difficult to understand, let alone Lawyers to comprehend. Often such ambiguity were left to the respective local authorities to interpret resulting in delay of granting approval, professional unknowingly venture into 'landmines' and caught with liabilities of failing to comply with the UBBL. This is the right forum to discuss the implication of such amended UBBL with regards to professional liabilities.


