## THE LATEST TRENDS IN INTERNATIONAL ARBITRATION

AND SELECTING THE RIGHT TRIBUNAL FOR YOUR CASE

The QMUL (Queen Mary University of London) / White & Case 2015 survey on international arbitration demonstrates the latest trends in international arbitration. The speaker, a member of White & Case's international arbitration group and member of the working party which developed the survey introduces the survey, its key themes and insightful results. He then moves on to discuss the vexed issue of arbitrator selection and presents some of the latest thinking in this area.

He was one of the initial three members of the Regional Coordinating Committee for the Asia Chapter of the ICC's Young Arbitrator Forum from 2008-2011 and has maintained a continual focus on disputes in the Asia region.



Dato' Anantham Kasinather practiced law for some 38 years in the Commercial Bar with the firm of Skrine from November 1972 until appointed a Judicial Commissioner in August 2009. Dato' was cited as a leading Shipping practitioner in Malaysia in several editions of the Asia Pacific Legal 500. He was also cited as one of three leading Commercial Litigators in Malaysia in the International Who's Who of Business Lawyers in its 2002 and 2003 Edition.

His areas of practice include Admiralty, Commercial Law, Insurance Law including Professional Indemnity, Arbitration and Defamation.

Dato' was appointed as Judicial Commissioner of the High Court of Malaya on 14th August 2009. He was confirmed as a Judge of the High Court of Malaya on 9th August 2010. Dato' was elevated to the Court of Appeal on 10th August 2011 and continued to serve in the Court of Appeal until his retirement on 30th May 2014.
